- 1. Entry is open to members and guests over the age of eighteen years (herein referred to as patrons) of St Marys Rugby League Club, after legal entrance to the Club.
- 2. Patrons may purchase tickets from 6pm each Friday from the Sapphire Lounge for the raffle on that night only.(Unless otherwise advertised times)
- 3. Tickets are \$1 for a sheet of six numbers.
- 4. Tickets will be sold in consecutive numbers only.
- 5. There is no limit on the number of tickets each patron may purchase.
- 6. Employees of St Marys Rugby League Club are not eligible to participate in the raffle at any time.
- 7. The Board of Directors of St Rugby League Club are not eligible to participate in the raffle at any time.
- 8. Contractors of St Marys Rugby League Club and their staff are not eligible to participate in the raffle at any time.
- 9. Persons conducting the raffle and associated with the raffle are not permitted to participate as a player.
- 10. The raffle draw will commence at 7.30pm each Friday evening in the Sapphire Lounge and will conclude by 9pm as Department of Gaming & Racing regulations state a "raffle session cannot be of a greater duration than three hours" and "that three hour period includes the time set aside for selling tickets and conducting all draws for prizes".<sup>1</sup>
- 11. The draw will be conducted by an approved Random Number Generator BSG Super Draw. The raffle host will program in the first and last number sold.
- 12. Winning numbers will be displayed on the screens and announced by public address to most areas of the Club.
- 13. On announcing each number on the PA system, patrons must present themselves to the competition host to claim their prize within 4 minutes.
- 14. It is the patron's responsibility to position themselves at the time of the draw in an area of the club where they can satisfactorily hear the public address and physically claim the prize within 4 minutes.
- 15. If a prize winner does not claim the prize within 4 minutes after the result is first announced, the result must be announced at least three more times (if not claimed before then). If the prize is unclaimed after the fourth announcement, a redraw will take place.
- 16. All prizes are carded by the promotional host prior to the raffle. Corresponding cards are placed on the raffle table. Patrons will be asked to select a playing card from the raffle table. The patron wins the prize that matches the card chosen.
- 17. Prizes are not redeemable for cash and cannot be exchanged for another prize.
- 18. After winning a perishable prize it is the patron's responsibility to ensure these prizes are kept within the appropriate time and temperature controls.
- 19. In the event that a dispute as to the conduct of the raffle arises, the complainant should address the issue in the first instance with the raffle host, at the time of the issue arising. Should the situation not be resolved, the host will contact the Duty Manager to address the concerns of the patron. If the issue impacts the outcomes of the raffle, it will be dealt with at that time; otherwise, a resolve will be sought following the conclusion of the raffle. The Duty Manager's decision is final and no correspondence shall be entered into.

- 20. Meat trays returned to us and found to be below quality will be replaced. Once the meat tray has been returned to our suppliers and found to be of good quality the tray cannot be returned to the patron due to Health Department regulations. The prize and any associated costs to the patron shall be forfeited in this instance.
- 21. The last number drawn at the conclusion of the raffle will receive a \$100 mystery prize that will be themed to the month.
- 22. Any raffle prize is offered on an "as is" basis, and the Club does not provide any warranties or guarantees regarding the functionality or condition of the prize.
- 23. Once the raffle prize has been distributed to the winner, any issues or defects with the prize are not the responsibility of the Club. The winner acknowledges that the Club is not accountable for any non-functioning or defective prize.
- 24. The winner accepts the prize in it's current condition and agrees not to hold the Club liable for any damages, losses, or injuries that may arise from the use or ownership of the prize.
- 25. The Club is not responsible for facilitating or resolving any warranty-related matters.

## **Breakdown of bonuses**

6 numbers for \$1.

Minimum spend is \$5.00

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$5 purchase = 30 numbers + 15 bonus numbers

$10 purchase = 60 numbers + 30 bonus numbers

$15 purchase = 90 numbers + 60 bonus numbers

$20 purchase = 120 numbers + 90 bonus numbers

$25 purchase = 150 numbers + 120 bonus numbers

$30 purchase = 180 numbers + 150 bonus numbers

$35 purchase = 210 numbers + 180 bonus numbers

$40 purchase = 240 numbers + 210 bonus numbers

$45 purchase = 270 numbers + 240 bonus numbers
